Thank goodness someone intercepted this, or it may have been worse. Always be gware and don't let your guard down. Very unfortunate incident.

Needs:

For ALL teams playing in WV, even out of state teams, at ALL levels, kickoffs and punts ARE required. Teams do not have the option to waive this requirement.

The numbering requirement must also be enforced for ALL levels of play. Coaches know this and have been given this information. This cannot be waived. Officials, do you jobs and apply the rules consistently across ALL areas of the state. No official has the right to waive this state requirement. Don't let coaches use the line, "We have done it all year". Your answer to this is "Well, you're not doing it tonight"!
