# What's Happening?

As we approach the halfway point of the regular season, I have still not received many of the Crew Chiefs schedules that should have been requested of you by your local board leadership to submit to me for playoff consideration. Please get those to me ASAP.

Eye black is still a problem statewide, especially at Middle School levels. Middle school games play by the same rules as Varsity, and this is an instructional time for these players so they learn how to do it right. Take this level of game seriously as this level is very important to the participants.

## **Needs:**

If you hear electronic megaphones/bull horns being used by spectators, get with game administration so they can be removed. These are not allowed at football games.

Remember, if you disqualify a player for an excessive act (personal foul or unsportsmanlike conduct foul), make sure the word "Flagrant" is put in your Special Report. This is very important from an Administrative process.

Language is still a focus if it is Excessive or directed at the opponent. Penalize for unsportsmanlike conduct only. Do not disqualify unless it is the players 2<sup>nd</sup>

#### Ruling:

Since the foul occurred prior to the ready for play signal, the 15 yard penalty will be enforced making it 1st and 10 from the 24 vard line. If the UNS foul would have occurred after the ready for play, it would have 1st and Have Fun! Safe Travels! goal from the 24 yard line.
