Question: 4th and 13 at Team B's 40 yard line. A11 carries the ball to the 38 yard line where B20 picks up the ball carrier by wrapping him up and carrying him backwards 3 yards where he then hip tosses the ball carrier to the ground in a suplex motion. A personal foul was called

Ruling: Since the runner's forward progress was stopped, the play is over. The throw down to the ground was dead ball action, so it is a dead ball personal foul. Mark the 15 yard penalty off against Team B, and it will be 1st and 10 for B since the ball goes over on downs.
