With a Supermoon getting ready to occur at the end of the end, stay on top of player behavior and penalize when appropriate.

## Needs:

Remember, please give all Head Coaches an Introductory Card prior to the game. Thanks to everyone that submitted Special Reports involving issues with the operators of 40/25 and Game clocks. Keep submitting those if issues arise in the incorrect operation of those.

Discuss keys prior to the snap and when you need to go into Zone coverage on a play. Make sure everyone is on the same page when knowing who they are watching and areas they are responsible for as several holding penalties were missed especially on the edges of run/pass plays.

### Game Administration Issues

#### Player Equipment Knowing Your Keys



#### Play Of The Week:

K 4<sup>th</sup> & 10 from the 50 yard line. K punts and K12 commits KCI at R's 9 yard line and the ball bounces into the EZ. What are the options for Team R?

Ruling: R could take the result of the play and have 1<sup>st</sup> & 10 at the 20 yard line. Or R could penalize K 15 yards from the previous spot and replay 4<sup>th</sup> down. Or, they can accept the penalty at the spot of KCI, and have the 15 yards enforced from that spot, making is 1<sup>st</sup> & 10 at the 24 yard line.

### Week 2 Focus

As we go into Week 2, let's focus on being good dead ball officials and being alert to action that occurs in and around the piles. Be observant and talk to players to let them know of your presence as many unnecessary acts unrelated to football can take place during this time.

Nice job in Week 1 on the new defenseless receiver rule. Continue to be aware of the new change and let me know of any plays in your game that can be viewed and be a learning tool for all other officials across the state. We must learn from everyone else's experiences.
