What's Happening?

Restricted Area Enforced- Possibly lost an official for the year who tripped over a ball boy in the white restricted area. **NO ONE** can be in this area when the ball is alive.

Tinted Visors- CANNOT be worn unless you are presented a letter from the WVSSAC Office. A doctor's note IS NOT ACCEPTABLE.

Special Reports- For High School games, select "High-Varsity", not "Middle-^{ve}Varsity". Very important to select the correct level of play.

Play Of The Week:

Team A lines up for the try for point. During the play, A80 catches the pass in the back of the end zone for a successful 2 point try. During the play, A56 and A71 are in the end zone blocking members of Team B.

Ruling:

The restrictions for the offensive team on a pass play begin with the snap. Members of the offensive team are not allowed to go downfield and initiate a block. This is OPI. Since the try was successful, penalize 15 yard from the previous spot and replay the try.

Week 2 Focus

For crews using 6 men, when the snap is from the 20 yard line to the 10 yard line, FJ & SJ initial position is the goal line. DO NOT come off of the GL unless the pass which is airborne takes you off of it deeper into the EZ.

When the ball is snapped, do not drift a yard or two into the EZ. Stay at the GL throughout the play except for the above scenario.

Be better as an individual in Week 2 than you were in Week 1
