Defenseless Receiver Tips

- If the ball is tipped by the defense,
 defenseless receiver contact rules still apply
- Announcement made for fouls on defenseless receivers will be as follows:
- "Personal Foul, Illegal Contact on a Defenseless Receiver, #86, 15 yard penalty from the previous spot" Not a tack on foul
- We must say illegal because all contact on a defenseless receiver is not illegal.



Illegal Equipment/Player Must Remove

• If players have a mouthpiece already in, they cannot display a secondary mouthpiece in this manner (Green hanging one). This is an adornment and must be removed before participation.



Line Up Cards

 Even though there is no longer a Coaches Rating given, ALL Head Coaches at ALL Levels of Play will be given an Introductory Card with the names of your crew and registration numbers

Fouls By B That Result In A Safety

- If B fouls in the end zone and the play ends in the end zone that would result in a safety, we will penalize B from the previous spot
- If there is change a possession, and B fouls in the end zone where the play would result in a safety, we would then penalize from the goal line.
