Play Of The Week:

A7 is a covered wide-out. 1st and 10 at A's 40 yard line. A7 goes downfield, and attempts to catch a forward pass at B's 30 yard line. A7 muffs the pass, but does not catch it. The pass falls incomplete. What is the ruling?

Answer:

There are 2 fouls on the play. A7 in an ineligible man downfield, Plus, you have illegal touching. The ineligible man downfield will be declined and the illegal touching will be enforced 5 yards from the previous spot and loss of down. 2nd and 15 @ A's 35 vard line.
